



Farmbassadors Program Overview

Farmbassadors are leaders who volunteer regularly at the Farm throughout our main season (May through October) help keep things running smoothly at the farm. They support farm staff in on-the-farm tasks. They show volunteers how to carry out cultivation tasks around the Farm and support our programming. We are looking for folks who are passionate about the Farm's mission of connecting people to healthy food and participating in a local food system. Interest in gardening and growing food is great! No experience necessary. Just come ready to learn and jump in where needed.

All Farmbassadors will be trained in general how-tos for carrying out basic weekly farm tasks such as harvesting, washing, and bundling produce, watering, seeding and planting. They will also learn more about what's growing around the farm. Interested Farmbassadors can This is a great opportunity for folks who want to give back to their community and deepen their experience in agriculture, community service, and environmental stewardship. Volunteers who have already been helping out at the farm are also encouraged to join this program. We can offer hours for community service, recommendation letters and references, a fair share of farm fresh fruits and veggies, and more!

Time commitment: We are looking for folks who can help at the Farm at least 3 times a month, Saturday availability at least once a month!

Farmbassadors may also be trained additionally on specific programs around the Farm!

- FarmFridgers: These Farmbassadors help operate the Fairgate Community Fridge. Keeping the fridge clean, picking up donations, helping distribute food to our community members and more.
- FarmHandlers: Farmbassadors who can take leadership in helping with our composting program, maintaining our indoor hydroponic system, and other on the farm tasks. *Must be able to lift 50+ lbs regularly!*
- FarmStanders: Farmbassadors who can be trained on helping with our Pay-What-You-Can farmstand! Setting up and breaking down our on-site and mobile markets, operating or assisting with the farmstand, picking up produce from other farms, and more.
